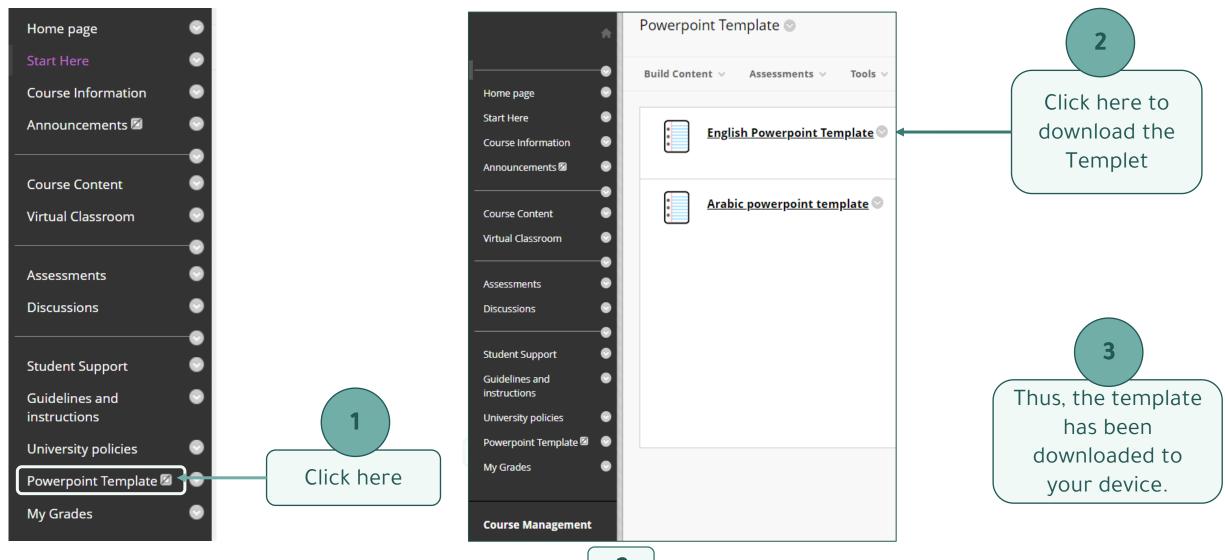


Dear Faculty Members

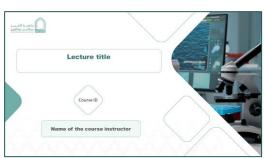
Download the presentation file from your course, through the "Presentation Template" tab, following these steps:



After opening the downloaded template, several slides will appear containing all the content of the course presentation. You can choose a suitable design and delete any unwanted slides.

First: The lecture cover slide

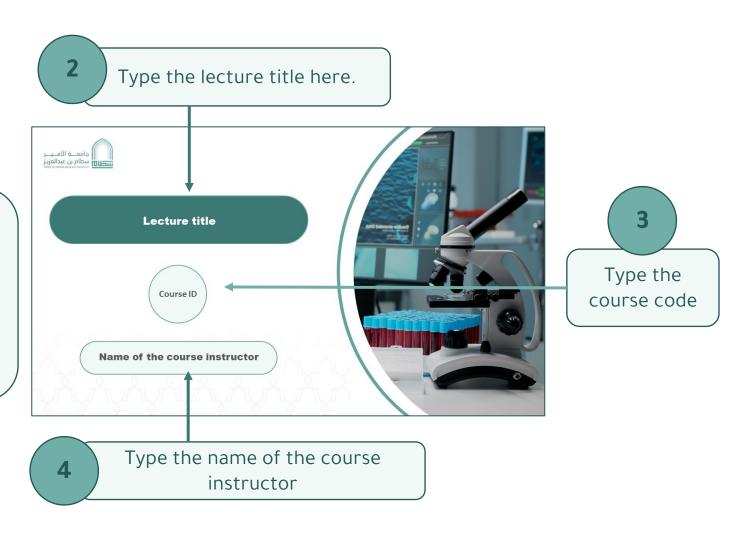




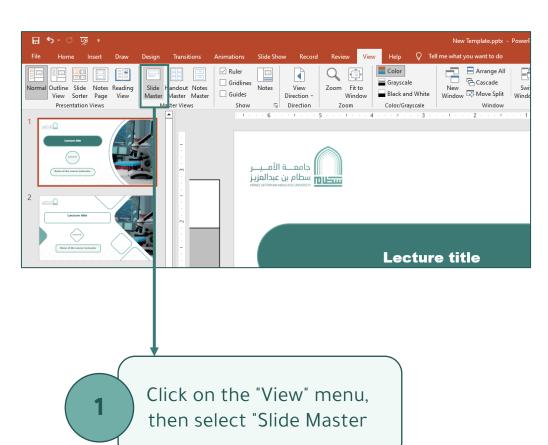

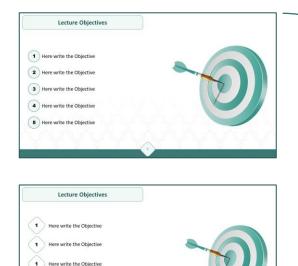




Click the right mouse button on the image and select "Change Picture." Choose the location of the image and select the image you want to use.

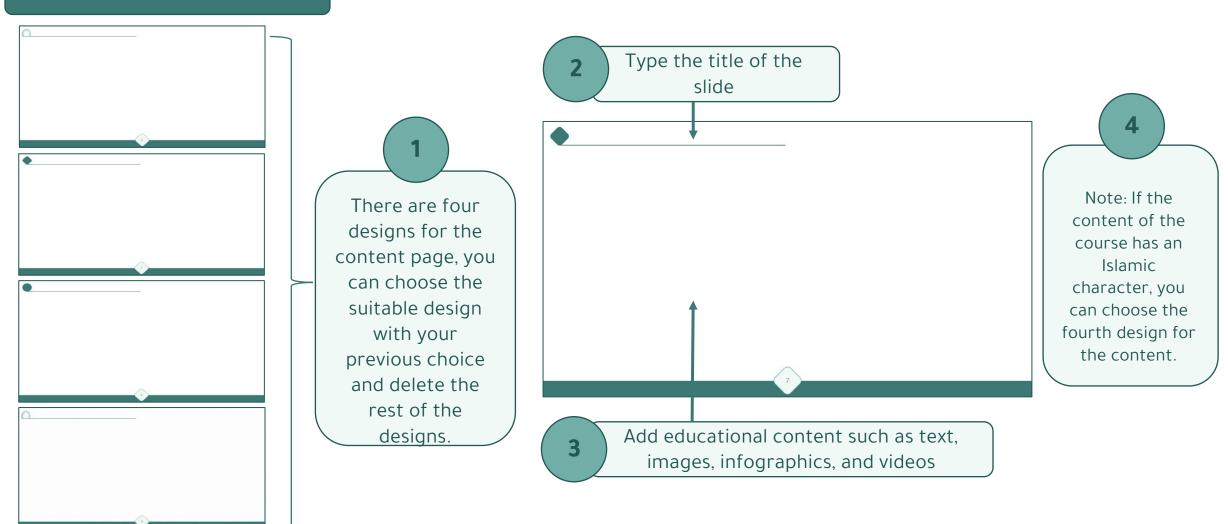

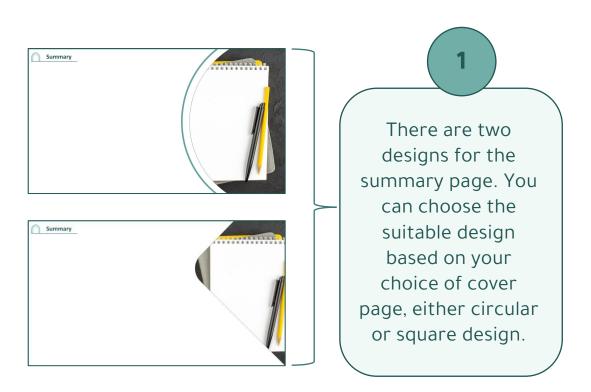
Through this screen, you can write the slide title, and in the blank space, you can add educational content such as text, images, infographics, and videos.

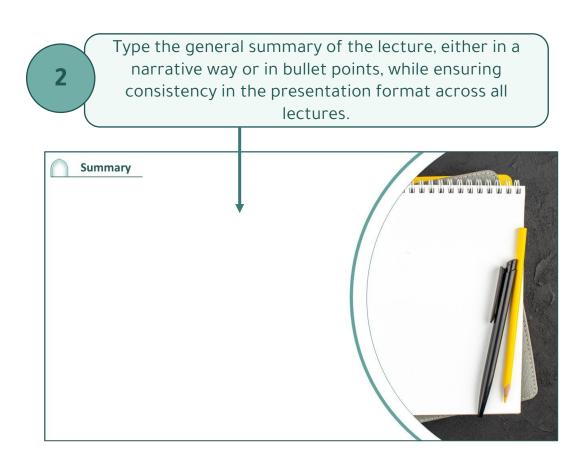
Third: Lecture content slide
